

CORRECTIONS TO THE CURRENT MOTORCYCLE MANUALS

(effective 3-7-2019)

NEW RIDING INFORMATION AND LAWS FOR 2018

(addition)

Motorcycle Instruction Permit (M.S. 169.974. Subd.2)

Effective August 1, 2018

A person with a motorcycle instruction permit is allowed to ride a motorcycle on the interstate highway.

On SKILLS TEST CHECKLIST

(the 6th bullet point is different)

I have current proof of insurance for the motorcycle I am taking the test on. Acceptable proof of insurance includes: original insurance card issued by the company; policy declaration pages; e-insurance printed from the insurance company website or presented on an electronic device.

On MOTORCYCLE II

(one deletion and website address change)

You may not ride on any interstate highway (has been removed)

The online address is different - dvs.dps.mn.gov *(instead of www.mndriveinfo.org)*

On MOTORCYCLE III

(costs at the top of the second column are different)

Operator's permit under age 21, valid to age 21 - \$9.75 *(was \$17.75)*

Duplicate of operator's permit - \$5.25 *(was \$13.25)*

Renewal, age 21 or older - \$15.75 *(was \$23.75)*
